Acknowledgment, Acceptance and Deed of Re-Conveyance or Conveyance/Power of Attorney extension	<b>Red Cursive for Re-Conveyance, Blue Cursive for Conveyance.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter)
Certificate of Assumed Name /Notice of Transfer of Reserved Name	<b>Blue Cursive, No © symbol, no all rights reserved, no without prejudice.</b>
Act of Expatriation and Oath of Allegiance for JOHN MARK DOE (Cestui Que Vie)	<b>Blue Cursive</b> using the SAME NAME written on document, <b>no all rights reserved, no without prejudice. Do not use if no middle name.</b>
Act of Expatriation and Oath of Allegiance for JOHN M. DOE (Public transmitting Utility)	<b>Blue Cursive</b> using the SAME NAME on document. <b>no all rights reserved, no without prejudice. Do not use if no middle name</b>
Act of Expatriation and Oath of Allegiance for JOHN DOE (Ward of the State)	<b>Blue Cursive</b> using the SAME NAME on document. <b>no all rights reserved, no without prejudice.</b>
Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act	<b>Blue Cursive.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter)
Cancellation of All Powers of Attorney	<b>Blue Cursive,</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter)
Cancellation of All POA with Exceptions	<b>Blue Cursive</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter)
DNA Paramount Claim	<b>Blue Cursive.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter)

## Notarising and Autographing/Signing thy Documents

Declaration of Political Status	<b>Blue Cursive. Printed in Purple</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter) Requires a <b>gold raised embossed seal from the Notary</b> . Also on the back of the document and cover page, draw a red diagonal line from upper left to lower right ending with the pre-decimal pence stamp with diagonal gold autograph across the stamp.
Notice of Intent, Fee Schedule	<b>Blue Cursive.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter)
Living Testimony in the form of an Affidavit (LTA)	<b>Red Cursive.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter)
Baby Deed/Record of Life (replaces BC)	<b>Document printed in Red - Blue Cursive</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter) Requires a <b>gold raised embossed seal from the Notary</b> . Also on the back of the document and cover page, draw a red diagonal line from upper left to lower right ending with the pre-decimal pence stamp with diagonal gold autograph across the stamp.
Common Carry Declaration	<b>Blue Cursive.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter) Requires a <b>gold raised embossed seal from the Notary</b> . Also on the back of the document and cover page, draw a red diagonal line from upper left to lower right ending with the pre-decimal pence stamp with diagonal gold autograph across the stamp.
Marriage Paperwork	<b>Red Cursive,</b> No need to be recorded, just published. Cover Letter to Cancel Marriage License/Contract
Property Paperwork (Allonge, Deed of Reconveyance, Declaration of Permanent Homestead and Domicile, and Public Notice and Testimony in the form of an Affidavit)	<b>Blue Cursive.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter) Requires a <b>gold raised embossed seal from the Notary</b> . Also on the back of the document and cover page, draw a red diagonal line from upper left to lower right ending with the pre-decimal pence stamp with diagonal gold autograph across the stamp.
Witness Testimony Affirmation	<b>Blue Cursive.</b> By: First Middle Last© (red thumbprint should touch your autograph over last letter) Legal Age is 18, Lawful is 21, while a Public Notary validates 18+ and Name, we are walking Lawfully.

Please note, Mistakes are made all the time and Judge Anna says to not get caught up in the details, it's good to get right, but it is thy intention to return to the Land and Soil that matters.
